WL5011: Spanish I CP\* 5 credits per semester, yearlong course

Prerequisite: None Grade level: 9th—12th

The semester grade will be calculated with the final exam contributing 20% of the grade and the above components making up the other 80%.

#### Final Exam:

The final exam will be a summative assessment of units covered in the semester.

#### **Tests and Quizzes:**

All tests and quizzes will be taken during our regularly scheduled class meeting. Quizzes may be announced or unannounced (pop quizzes) and may cover material from previous classes or from assigned reading/homework. All tests will be announced, with dates posted on the course website (Blackboard). Make-up tests may be given in the Prep Plus Make-Up Test Center, unless arrangements have been made with Ms. Cooper. Please speak with Ms. Cooper if you have missed an exam.

#### Homework/Classwork:

Assignments will be given and described in detail in class and will only be listed with their due date on Blackboard. In some cases, assignments may be completed during class time (classwork). Other assignments will be given as homework. In this class, assignments from the workbook will be the majority of the homework assigned.

#### Late work:

Late work will be accepted for partial credit. Projects, papers and presentations that are turned in late will be marked down 5% each day they are late. Remember, any credit is better than a zero!



## **Attendance and Classroom Behavior**

### **School Attendance Policy:**

- Work missed due to suspension or unexcused absences will result in a "zero" grade and cannot be made up.
- Missed class participation credit due to absence cannot always be made up.
- A student will have two days for each excused day absent to complete make up work.
- 12 or more absences during one semester (excused or unexcused) will result in a grade of zero on any missed assignments. "Work" includes all classwork, homework, projects, quizzes and tests.
- Student absence due to a school related activity (sports, competitions, field trips, etc.) does not count towards the school attendance policy.
- Teachers will notify parents or guardians after the 3rd and 5th absence. Counselors will contact parents or guardians for absences 6,8, and 9. Dean of Students will contact for all absences after 9.

#### **Absences:**

Should you be absent any given day, it is your responsibility to check Blackboard and with classmates for any missed work and to turn it in within two days of an excused absence. No work will be accepted for unexcused absences.
